Golf Outings at The Bucks Club

On the day of your golf event, we want you to be able to relax and enjoy the company of your guests. It is recommended that any event planning coordinators and any volunteers arrive one hour to one and a half hours prior to the start of the event. Your guests should be notified to arrive at least 1/2 hour prior to the event and up to one-hour prior if they would like to hit practice balls.

When arriving at the Bucks Club for your outing, you will see registration tables surrounding the bag drop area. The attendants will stage your golf bags onto the appropriate carts.

We will provide your registration staff with an alphabetized list of all players with hole assignments through our computerized system, as well as cart signs affixed to all carts. Format/rule sheets, as well as team scorecards will be attached to the steering wheels of all carts.

Once your scorecards have been turned in to the golf professionals, you are free to meet up with your fellow golfers and enjoy your banquet luncheon or dinner and awards presentation.

Event Fees

Event Starts & Formats

Shotgun Starts – Available either at 9AM or 1PM the day of your event. All foursomes begin play at the same time on different holes, accommodates up to 144 players. Our professional event planning staff will direct your guests to be seated in their golf cars 10 minutes prior to the scheduled starting time. At that time, we will go over the rules for the days play, contest holes and any information about The Bucks Club that will assist your guests. The golf event staff will provide a rules sheet for each of the tournament golf cars that will explain the rules of play, contests and golf course information. <u>A minimum of 100 players is</u> <u>necessary to close the golf course for any outside event.</u>

Tee Time Starts – One foursome tees off every 10 minutes. During tee time starts, our staff will assist your guests arriving to the first tee on time. Our starter will inform your guests of course information as well as the rules of play for the day. Rules sheets will be provided to your guests if needed to help remind them of the day's events while on the golf course.

Contest Hole Markers - Our event planning staff will prepare the contest hole signs for you (long drive/closest to the pin) and have them placed on the golf course in the appropriate locations. Upon completion of your event, our event planning staff will collect the contest sign markers and bring them to our scoring area to post the winners.

Skill/Contest Prizes

Closest To The Pin – This is a popular contest to have for any size group. The "Bucks Club" will provide a proximity sign marker for your golf tournament event. This is usually held on a par three hole on the course and the participants will mark their name on the sign when they hit their shot closest to the hole. The sign is moved time a player hits their tee shot closer than the previous player. The final player to come through that hole and have the closest shot to the pin will be awarded as the winner. Hole #4, #6, #13 and #16 are the Par 3 holes.

Longest Drive - This is also a popular golf contest to have with group play. It works similar to the closest to the pin contest but the player with the longest tee shot in the fairway will mark their name on the proximity marker. Again, the last player to play the designated hole with the longest drive will be awarded the winner. Hole #7 and #15 are the holes that we recommend.

While On The Golf Course

During your guest's play, we will have on-course hosts assist your group with pace of play and help answer any questions while on the golf course. We ask that each group try and stay up with the group in front of them. Our staff will help everyone finish in a timely manner.

Practice Facility

Complementary practice balls are included as part of your event prior to their round of golf. The range is limited to 175 yards and **only** irons may be used. The chipping area located adjacent to the 18th green and the putting green is also available to your guests.

Dress Code

<u>All Players</u>

Golf shoes or smooth soled shoes (sneakers) are required by all players

<u>Men</u>

- > Denim of any type is not permitted
- Shirts with collars are mandatory (mock neck golf shirts with banded collars are also approved)
- > Shorts are acceptable within 3" cut above the knees

Ladies

- > Denim of any type is not permitted
- > Tank/halter tops are not permitted
- ➢ Golf shirts, shorts and/or skirts are mandatory

Golf Carts

All players are required to utilize golf carts and to obey the rules of their operation. Any damage to the golf cars is the responsibility of the group who organized the outing; this includes personal injury liability and the cost(s) associated with repairs and damages. All cars are inspected prior to play, as well as, immediately after the completion of play.

Conditions of Contract

Prices and dates are guaranteed upon a deposit of **\$500**. Deposits are non-refundable and non-transferable.

A guaranteed golf and/or food and beverage count is due seven (7) days prior to the event. This is the minimum number that will be billed plus any additions. **The balance is payable at the completion of the event.** Payment can be made by cash, company or organizational check, or credit card.

Three (3) days prior to the event, a complete schedule and player pairing must also be provided to the pro shop.

No food or beverage including alcohol, other than the contents of this package will be permitted by a patron, guest or invitee.

Prearranged rain dates are impossible to promise. However, we will reschedule any outing that is cancelled, due to inclement weather when possible.

Event Cancellation

Events cancelling due to severe weather the day of the event will receive 100% of the deposit monies.
